TRANSFER OF AN INDUSTRIAL EMISSIONS LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 94 of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992
as amended

Licence Register No: **W0232-01**

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers licence Register No W0232-01 and any associated amendments from Dublin City Council, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8, to Dublin Waste to Energy Limited, Arthur Cox Building, Earlsfort Terrace, Dublin 2, CRO No. 399060. Licence Register No W0232-01 licenses the carrying on of the activities set out below at Dublin City Council, Pigeon House Road, Poolbeg, Dublin 4, subject to twelve conditions, as set out in the Licence.

Activities Licensed:-

The licensed activities are amended to be as follows:

- 11.3 (a) Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incineration plants or in waste co-incineration plants for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 tonnes per hour
- 11.1 The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Waste Management Act, 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any limitations on waste recovery and disposal activities specified in this Part in accordance with the Third Schedule and Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended including, where applicable, any refused waste disposal and recovery activities from the Third Schedule and Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act as amended shall continue to apply.


In accordance with Section 94 of the Act, Dublin Waste to Energy Limited, is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, that may arise.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 94(5)(a) of the Act, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Dublin Waste to Energy Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like Industrial Emissions licence. Pursuant to Section 94(5)(b) of the Act, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Dublin Waste to Energy Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the programme officer's report
