re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr Dillon,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Roadstone's Mullaghcrone Quarry, Platin & Cruicerath townland, Donore, Co. Meath.

Having examined the documentation submitted, and in light of an e-mail dated 19/09/2014 received from the planning authority on the planning status of the development (available on our website www.epa.ie), I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 and Article 13 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

Please submit a letter from the Planning Authority confirming whether Subsequent Consent is required OR whether the current Planning Permission/Registration, granted by Meath County Council is adequate to facilitate the backfilling operations, which is currently the subject of a waste licence application by Roadstone Ltd.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (Application Form and EIS) which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within 6 weeks of the date of this notice.

Please note that the application's register number is W0287-01.
