3. **Recommended Determination on an Application for a Review of an Industrial Emissions Licence**

The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing, Research and Resource Use that the Agency approve the Recommended Determination to grant an IED Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Determination and the Report of the Inspector dated 6 November 2014. The Directors noted that this is a review of Waste Licence No. W0167-02, issued by the Agency on 16 February 2011.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Inspector’s Report

The Inspector’s Report was noted. The Directors noted that the Dioxin Survey in Cow’s Milk will continue in this area for the foreseeable future.

Recommended Determination

Decision & Reasons for the Decision

Amend the first sentence in the third paragraph as follows; ‘It is considered that the Environmental **6th November 2014**) contains on the environment.

Condition

7.1.5 Amend Condition as follows; ‘The licensee shall explore and *develop, where feasible, suitable* export of heat.’

7.3 Amend third sentence of the Condition as follows; ‘The Licensee shall *develop, where feasible,* opportunities incinerator residues.’

8.1.1 Amend Condition as follows; ‘The licensee shall ensure *for re-use, recycled* or on the environment.’

8.4.3 Delete the second sentence of the Condition as follows; ‘*Once approved by the Agency* *at the installation.*’

8.4.4.2(ii) Amend Condition as follows: ‘The taking of representative samples, unless *inappropriate as far as possible* specified in Condition 8.4.4.1.’

C.2.2. Monitoring of Storm Water Emissions

Amend Note 1 as follows; ‘Trigger levels of with Condition 6.16.’

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Indaver Ireland Limited, for their facility at Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath, Register of Licence No. W0167-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
