A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision.
