Dear Mr. Murphy,

I refer to your application for a licence.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, that the following information is required in support of the application under Regulation 9 of the Regulations:

1. As required under Regulation 9(2)(h), state in detail how the requirements of section 83(5)(a)(i) to (v) and (vii) to (xa) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act of 1992, as amended, will be met.
2. As required under Regulation 9(2)(h), provide BAT analysis which include all BAT Conclusions in the *Reference document on Best Available Techniques for Energy Efficiency* and complete table on *Conclusions on BAT from the Emissions from Storage BAT Reference Document* available at on the Agency's website at <http://www.epa.ie/pubs/forms/lic/industrial%20emissions/batconemissionstostoragebref.html>.
3. As required under Regulation 9(2)(n), provide a baseline report in accordance with section 86B of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended. The baseline report should be prepared in accordance with European Commission Guidance concerning baseline reports under Article 22(2) of Directive 2010/75/EU on industrial emissions (2014/C 136/03).
 - a. Inclusive in this report please provide a quantified assessment of soil and groundwater pollution, if any, by the relevant hazardous substances you have identified. Please also take into consideration their degradation products and metabolites.
4. As required under Regulation 9(2)(w), provide an updated non-technical summary that includes information on existing and proposed point sources of emissions to air.
5. As required under Regulation 9(4)(a), provide a copy of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the notice in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Environmental Protection Agency (Industrial Emissions)(Licensing) Regulations 2013 has been published.
6. As required under Regulations 9(4)(b) and 9(4)(d)(ii), provide a copy of the text of the site notice erected or fixed in accordance with Regulation 6 of said Regulations and provide a drawing showing the location of this site notice.

7. As required under Regulation 9(4)(c), provide a copy of the notice given to the planning authority under section 87(1)(a) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act of 1992, as amended.
8. As required under Regulation 9(4)(d), please provide three up to date drawings of the installation, as follows:

Drawing 1

- The proposed site boundary; and
- The location of all buildings, storage areas/tanks, weighbridge and other aspects of the installation.

Drawing 2

- The area of land leased by Ormonde Organics Ltd. superimposed onto a drawing of the proposed site boundary.

Drawing 2

- The area authorised under planning permission referred to in Section B.3 of the licence application form.

The purpose of this request is to ensure that all of the installation's activities are enclosed within the site boundary and that Ormonde Organics Ltd. are entitled to so designate the site boundary.

In addition to the above please ensure that the updated non-technical summary as referred to in Point 4 above reflects the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *eight weeks* of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should be directed to Ms. Noeleen Keavey, Administration Officer, Office of Climate, Licensing, Resources & Research.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact Ms. Ewa Babiarczyk at the number above.
