Re: Notice pursuant to Regulation 28 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of the proposed determination on a licence review application by Indaver Ireland Limited, Reg. No. W0167-03

Dear Mr Jones

I refer to the Agency's proposed determination on the above referenced licence review application. I am to advise that, pursuant to Regulation 28 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, the Agency requests that you submit further information to enable the Agency to fully consider the third party objections received.

During consideration of the objections, the need for the following information was identified:

1. In your letter to the Agency dated 31 October 2012 (Re: Article 12 Compliance), reference is made to the Ekokem incinerator (Line 4) and authorisation to treat up to 30,000 of solid and liquid hazardous waste. However, the environmental permits for Ekokem Waste-to-Energy Plant 1 (Nro YSO/59/2006) and Plant 2 (Nro 56/2010/1) have been provided to the Agency and do not refer to Line 4. Clarify the reference to Line 4 and clarify whether the comparative figures are correct. (Copies of Ekokem permits for Plant 1 and Plant 2 are available on the EPA website).
2. Provide the relevant documentation used to support the statement in Attachment B.8 of the licence review application that the proposed amendments to the installation require no changes that would affect the continuing non-Seveso status of the site. Provide a copy of any correspondence exchanged with the Health and Safety Authority on this matter.
3. In the existing licence (Reg. No. W0167-02), there is a requirement for annual testing of flue gas treatment residue for its hazardous/non-hazardous classification, in accordance with Schedule C.4. Provide any relevant data from that analysis, including in particular any examination of its eco toxic properties, and provide an interpretation as to its relevance in the determination of the Seveso status of the installation. State what changes are expected to the chemical constituents of the flue gas treatment residue as a result of the introduction of hazardous waste. This projection should be based, at least in part, on the nature of flue gas treatment residue generated at other installations that treat waste of a similar profile to that proposed. In your response, state the source of any information used in projecting the nature


of the flue gas treatment residue and provide any information obtained on the constituents of flue gas treatment residues in other installations.

I am to request that you submit the specified information to the Agency no later than 3 March 2015. It should be noted that if the above specified information is not received by this time, the Agency will, after the expiration of the period, and without further notice, proceed with its consideration of the objection and make a final decision on the application.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay.

Your response to this request should be directed to Licensing Administration, Environmental Licensing Programme, Office of Climate, Licensing & Resource Use, Environmental Protection Agency, Headquarters, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford, quoting the register number.
