OEE Regional Enforcement provided a report with accompanying attachments on the 14th January 2014 detailing the result of the OEE's investigations to date in relation to odours, to be considered, as part of the licensing application, under S83 of the EPA Acts 1992 as amended.

OEE received odour complaints on the 12/12/14 and the 15/12/14 in relation to Brandon Products Ltd. The details of these complaints are outlined in table 1 and table 2 below as an addendum to the Section 83(2) report.

OEE carried out an odour assessment in the vicinity of Brandon Products Ltd. on the 12/12/14 between 14:30 and 15:53. OEE detected odours but these odours were not deemed to be at nuisance level during the time period of the odour assessment.
