RE:	Request for Technical Amendment to Waste Water Discharge Licence Register Number D0056-01 , for Midleton agglomeration.

Introduction

A Waste Water Discharge Licence for Midleton agglomeration by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on the 6th January 2011, Reg No. D0056-01.

Request for Technical Amendment

In correspondence to the Agency dated 11/11/2013, the Applicant requested that a technical amendment of this licence (Reg. No. D0056-01) be undertaken to amend the grid reference location for SW07 MIDL, increase the Control Limit Value (CLV) for the designated storm water overflows from a frequency of six spills/annum to 10 spills/annum and increase the 1.5% limit of total storm water collected in the relevant section of waste water works on the discharge volume for a storm overflow event to 20%.

Recommendation

I have considered the information submitted to the Agency, which involves amending the grid reference location for SW07 MIDL, increasing the Control Limit Value (CLV) for the designated storm water overflows from a frequency of six spills/annum to 10 spills/annum and increasing the 1.5% limit of total storm water collected in the relevant section of waste water works on the discharge volume for a storm overflow event to 20%.

I recommend that the request to technically amend the licence to amend the grid reference location for SW07 MIDL, increase the Control Limit Value (CLV) for the designated storm water overflows from a frequency of six spills/annum to 10 spills/annum and increase the 1.5% limit of total storm water collected in the relevant section of waste water works on the discharge volume for a storm overflow event to 20% be refused, on the basis that it constitutes a significant change to the existing licence conditions.
