Technical Committee Report

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

Objection 1: Condition 3.14.5 Security Fencing around Civic Amenity Area

Amend Condition 3.14.2 as follows; ‘The licensee shall maintain security fencing to prevent access by the general public using the civic amenity area to the remaining area of the installation.’

Objection 3: Condition 3.19 Wastewater Management and Stormwater Drainage

The Directors agreed the following amendments to Condition 3.19;

Amend Condition 3.19.1 to read as follows; ‘*Unless otherwise agreed by the Agency, within six months a wastewater treatment plant.*’

Amend Condition 3.19.2 to read as follows; ‘*Unless otherwise agreed by the Agency, within six months at emission point FE-1A.*’

Delete Condition 3.19.4.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Starrus Eco Holdings Limited, for their Installation at, Ballykeefe, Dock Road, Limerick, Register of Licence No W0082-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
