
The EPA has recently issued a Waste Water Discharge Licence for an agglomeration in County **Monaghan**, namely **Castleblayney**. The EPA is writing to inform you that it is the responsibility of **Monaghan County Council**, as the licensee, under Condition 6 of the Waste Water Discharge Licence to ensure that notifications, records and reports are submitted to the EPA in accordance with the requirements of the licence. In order to facilitate prompt and efficient reporting to the EPA all licensees are required to submit correspondence directly to the appropriate EPA Regional Inspectorate. Please note that there is now a provision for summary data to be submitted in electronic format to the EPA. This Guidance Note contains information on the contents and structure of an AER. Licensees should have regard to this Guidance Note when fulfilling the reporting requirements of the licence.

As part of the enforcement of Waste Water Discharge Licences, it is proposed that the EPA will be undertaking audits and discharge monitoring to determine compliance with licence conditions. The EPA has developed an Audit Report which details the information that will be required to determine compliance or otherwise with the licence conditions.
