3. Objection to Proposed Determination of an Application for an Industrial Emissions Licence

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Determination issued on 28 November 2014; 4 Third-Party objections; one Third-Party submission on the objections and the Report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing, Research and Resource Use.

## **Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

#### Objection 2.1.3: Chemical limits for hazardous waste

The Directors noted an error in the Technical Committees evaluation. It was noted that the reference in relation to BAT for the Waste Incineration BREF should have referred to BAT 4 and not BAT 3 as stated in the Technical Committee Report.

#### Objection 2.1.5: Calorific Values (CVs) of waste streams

The Directors agreed to amend Condition 8.4.3 as follows;

- (i) Procedures for:
  - (a) waste profiling from new and known customers;
  - (b) waste inspection prior to discharge into the bunker or direct injection into the furnace; and
  - (c) waste characterisation.

## Objection 2.3.6: Requirements of the Stockholm Convention

The Directors did not accept the recommendation of the Technical Committee and agreed not to amend the Decision & Reasons for the Decision.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Indaver Ireland Limited, for their Installation located at, Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath, Register of Licence No W0167-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
