No. W0167-03, for class 11.3.0:- Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incineration plants or in waste co-incineration plants- (a) for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 tonnes per hour, and (b) for hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 tonnes per day, located at Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath.</p>
