Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0272-01, in any future communication in respect of same.


You will be contacted in due course by an inspector in the Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, who will discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.

Where the licensable activity has not yet commenced, you are required to provide adequate notice to the Agency (to both the Enforcement Inspector from the Office Of Environmental Enforcement, and the licensing inspector from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use) of the intended date of commencement of the activity.
