I refer to previous correspondence in relation to the above referenced Waste Water Discharge Licence application.

I am to advise that Irish Water formally withdrew their application for a Waste Water Discharge Licence for the Courtmacsherry agglomeration on 17/02/2015. (See website for details of letter). The Agency formally acknowledged the withdrawal on 14/07/2015. That being the case, it is no longer the function of the Agency to consider any documentation received by it which relates to the above application.

I am to advise that Irish Water intend submitting a review application for a Waste Water Discharge Licence for the combined agglomerations of Courtmacsherry and Timoleague.
