WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT 1996 AS AMENDED

TRANSFER OF A LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 47(5) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended

Waste Licence Register No: **W0163-01**

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers licence register number W0163-01 from Bergin Waste Disposal Limited, Fairymount, Castlerea, County Roscommon, to Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta, CRO Number: 141912, Carrowbrowne, Headford Road, Galway. Licence Register No W0163-01 licenses the carrying on of the activities set out below at Bergin Waste Disposal Limited, Ballaghaderreen Industrial Estate, Ballaghaderreen, County Roscommon, subject to twelve Conditions, as set out in the waste licence.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Third Schedule to the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended

- Class 11. Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
This activity is limited to the bulking and transfer of waste at the facility.
- Class 12. Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
This activity is limited to the bulking and transfer of waste at the facility.
- Class 13. Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned was produced.
This activity is limited to the storage of wastes at the facility prior to movement off-site.



Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended

- Class 2. Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes):
This activity is limited to the recovery of paper, cardboard and wood at the facility.
- Class 3. Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds:
This activity is limited to the recovery of metals and metal compounds at the facility.
- Class 4. Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials:
This activity is limited to the recovery of inert wastes (e.g. construction and demolition wastes) at the facility.
- Class 11. Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule:
This activity is limited to the potential use of wastes on-site in the case of an emergency (e.g. the use of shredded wood as a spill absorbent).
- Class 13. Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced:
This activity is limited to the storage of wastes at the facility prior to recovery.


In accordance with Section 47(6) of the Acts, Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 47(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like licence. Pursuant to Section 47(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the programme officer's report.
