I am to refer to your incomplete application for a waste licence, Reg. No W0276-01 which was received by the Agency on 10 August 2010.

As you are aware, the Agency assessed your waste licence application for compliance with Article 12 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended and on 12 August 2011 and 6 November 2013, requested information under Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the said Regulations in order to complete the application. Two reminders letters were also issued on the 20 June 2014 and the 29 September 2015.


None of the above information has been received by the Agency to date, and the Agency is now of the opinion that the application has been abandoned.

I enclose a Notice in accordance with Article 21(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended. If no submission is received within the period specified in the notice, the application will be regarded as having been withdrawn. Failure to provide the outstanding information within the time limit will also be regarded as indicating withdrawal of the application


