The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing, Research and Resource Use that the Agency approve the Recommended Determination to grant an Industrial Emissions Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Determination, one Third Party submission and the Report of the Inspector dated 3 December 2015. The Directors noted that this is a review of Licence No. P0643-02, issued by the Agency on 21 November 2005.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Inspector’s Report

The Directors noted the Inspector’s Report.

A typographical error was noted on page 15 of the report under the heading of 7.6 Noise, where the reference to Condition 6.16 should have read Condition 6.17.

Recommended Determination

Conditions

- 6.17** Amend the first sentence of the Condition as follows; ‘The licensee shall carry out a noise survey of the site operations *as required* by the Agency. The survey as published by the Agency.’
- 12.1.1** Amend Condition heading as follows; ‘*12.1* Agency Charges’ and subsequent numbering i.e. 12.1.2 to *12.1.1* and 12.1.3 to *12.1.2*.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to AbbVie Ireland NL B.V., for their installation at Manorhamilton Road, Ballytivnan, Sligo, County Sligo, Register of Licence No P0643-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
