# 1. RECOMMENDATION

As the carrying on of the activity to which IE Licence Reg. No. W0186-01 relates has not been substantially commenced within a period of 10 years as per S.92[1][2] beginning on the date on which the licence was granted, I recommend the following:

- That the OEE issue a letter of notification to the Licensee under Section 92(1) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended stating that the licence has ceased to have effect from 24/11/2015 and the activity cannot now commence under this licence.
- 2. That the OEE notifies Cork County Council of the above.
- That the OEE make the relevant amendments to the OEE database and notifies the other internal offices [OCLRR, Accounts] to reflect the change in the licence's status to Ceased.

# 3. FACILITY LOCATION

The facility is located at Ringaskiddy Co. Cork.

## 4. FACILITY HISTORY

Indaver Ireland is licensed to operate an Industrial Emissions installation including a hazardous and non-hazardous waste incinerator at Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork. The installation, incorporating a civic waste facility, transfer station, fluidised bed incineration plant and moving grate incineration plant is authorised to accept up to 215,260 tonnes of waste per annum.

The facility was licensed on 24 November 2005. The licensed activity has not commenced. Condition 1.10 of the licence states that the specified period for the purposes of section 49(2) of the Waste Management Act is 8 years. This means that the licence was to expire on 24 November 2013. In October 2013, the Agency decided in accordance with section 49(2) of the Waste Management Act to extend the period of the licence for two years to 24 November 2015. In January 2014, the waste licence became an Industrial Emissions licence.

### 6. AGENCY'S ASSESSMENT

In November 2015, the licensee applied, to the Agency, for an extension of the duration of their Industrial Emissions licence, Reg. No. W0186-01 in relation to their waste facility at Ringaskiddy, County Cork. This was considered by the Board of the Agency at a meeting on the 08 December 2015. The Report of the ELP Inspector, Brian Meaney, dated 24 November 2015 and a First Party submission was submitted.

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommendation, to decline the request for an extension, as detailed in the Report of the Inspector dated 24 November 2015. The Directors agreed that the licensee would be informed by letter.
