In accordance with Section 9 of The Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2000, Atlas Environmental Ireland Limited hereby give notice to Laois County Council of its intention to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency to replace our existing Integrated Pollution Control License with a waste management licence for its facility located at Clonminam Industrial Estate, Portlaoise Co. Laois.

The change is required due to the reclassification of IPC scheduled activities and also to allow for expansion of the facility's capability in handling additional waste streams.

## Third Schedule:

- 7: Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcinations), which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 10 of this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcinations)
- 12: Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this schedule.
- 13: Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this schedule, pending collection on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

## Fourth Schedule

- 2: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances, which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes)
- 4: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials
- 5: Regeneration of acids or bases
- 8: Oil re-refining or other re-uses of oil (Principal Activity)
