RE:	Request for a Technical Amendment to Waste Water Discharge Licence Register Number D0348-01 , for Inniskeen agglomeration.

Introduction

A Waste Water Discharge Licence (WWDL) for the Inniskeen agglomeration was first granted by the Environmental Protection Agency on the 10/02/2010, Reg. No. D0348-01.

Request for Technical Amendment

In correspondence to the Agency dated 28/06/11, the licensee requested that a technical amendment of this licence (Reg. No. D0348-01) be undertaken to facilitate sampling and discharge coordinate corrections, a sewer layout revision and amendment of *Schedules A.1 Primary Waste Water Discharges, A.4 Storm Water Overflows and B.4 Ambient Monitoring*.

On consideration of the submission from the licensee with regard to this proposed change, I recommend that it is appropriate to deal with this request by way of Technical Amendment.

Schedule A: Discharges and Schedule B Monitoring

The licensee requests an amendment to *Schedules A.1 Primary Waste Water Discharges, A.4 Storm Water Overflows and B.4 Ambient Monitoring* seeking the revision of co-ordinates for the primary discharge location, a Storm Water Overflow and ambient monitoring locations.

The licensee justifies this request on the basis that the coordinates were either incorrect or not supplied in the application.

Birds Directive [79/409/EEC] & Habitats Directive [92/43/EEC]

A screening for Appropriate Assessment was undertaken to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is likely to have a significant effect on any European Site.

The activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European Site and the Agency considered, for the reasons set out below, that it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any

European Site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity was not required.

This determination is based on the fact that the proposed amendments will not result in a material change to the nature or volume of the discharge(s) from the agglomeration.

Recommendation

The amendment as drafted accedes to the request from the licensee in relation to Schedules A.1, A.4, B.1 and B.4 of licence Reg. No. D0348-01. It is considered appropriate to alter the existing licence in line with the request having regard to the provisions of Regulation 33(1)(c) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations, 2007 as amended.

I recommend that the licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached recommended Technical Amendment. Such an amendment does not result in the relevant requirements of Regulation 6(3) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations, 2007 as amended ceasing to be satisfied.
