Clerical or Technical Amendment Application Details

Proposed Alteration Description

Propose to amend Condition 5.9(d) to allow WEEE with hazardous codes be accepted into the Civic Waste Facility.

The agency have been aware that WEEE has been accepted on site since 2006. During an inspection on 15/6/03 (see attached) the agency looked for weatherproof covering for computers etc. Drogheda Borough Council responded to this on the 14/7/06 with a proposal to cover he WEEE storage area (see Attached). This cover was put in place in 2007.

During subsequent agency inspections this was deemed to be sufficient storage for WEEE.

The inability to accept such WEEE at Drogheda Civic waste facility would be a major blow for recycling in Drogheda as the site accepts approx 390 tonnes of WEE per annum.
