Clerical or Technical Amendment Application Details

Proposed Alteration Description

The ESE open yard area has been used for storage of wrapped bales.

Greenstar is instructed that baled and wrapped MSW must be stored on impermeable hardstand which drains to the effluent drainage system. The Agency has notified Greenstar that MSM should not be stored in areas that drain to the site storm water drainage system.

Following discussions with the Agency, it was agreed to make a submission proposing that drainage in he open yard area is diverted to the existing effluent drainage system. This necessitates a connection to the existing foul water drainage system which discharges to the public sewer at SE1.

Since a TA in 2010, foul waters generated from the facility are conveyed via the on-site foul water drainage system to the existing sanitary authority foul water system located adjacent to the Deep Water Quay access Road. The TA set a low discharge limit of 4.4m3/day (Schedule F.2).

Attached report from IE Consulting Engineers provides assessment of proposed discharge.

The sewer on Deep Water Quay appears to have sufficient spare capacity. As the proposed discharge is surface Jed in Rection purposes only in a meld ru water runoff there will be a requirement to attenuate flows (which you are already proposing). The maximum attenuated discharge proposed should be equivalent to the greenfield runoff.
