An Emergency Response Procedure has been put in place for this facility. A copy of this is included.

This procedure sets out the contact numbers of all the key personnel on-site, who are the responsible people. It also identifies the emergency contact numbers of relevant contractors and specialists that may be required in the event of an emergency. It further includes contact numbers for local Gardai, fire brigade and doctors.

This procedure is laminated and erected at a number of key locations around the facility. A register is in place to record all notifiable events on-site in the event of such an incident.

RESPONSIBILITY AND AUTHORITY FOR INITATING

- 1. DETERMINE THE REASONS WHY THE SPECIFIED REQUIREMENTS WERE NOT MET.**
- 2. DRAW UP A PLAN OF ACTION TO CORRECT THE NONCOMFORMITY WITH THE SPECIFIED REQUIREMENT**
- 3. IMPLEMENT PREVENTITIVE ACTIONS TO A LEVEL CORRESPONDING TO THE RISK ENCOUNTERED**
- 4. APPLY CONTROLS TO ENSURE THAT CORRECTIVE ACTIONS ARE TAKEN AND THAT THEY ARE EFFECTIVE**
- 5. IMPLEMENT AND RECORD ANY CHANGES IN PROCEDURES RESULTING FROM CORRECTIVE ACTION.**
- 6. PROVIDE SUCH APPROPRIATE TRAINING OR RETRAINING AS MAY BE NECESSARY.**
