1. RECOMMENDATION

As the carrying on of the activity to which Waste Licence W0215-01 relates has not been substantially commenced within a period of more than 3 years beginning on the date on which the licence was granted, I recommend the following:

- 1. That the OEE issue a letter of notification to the Licensee under Section 49(1) of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended stating that the licence has ceased to have effect at the end of the three year period following the date of grant of the licence and the activity cannot now commence under this licence.
- 2. That the OEE make the relevant amendments to the OEE database and notifies the other internal offices [OES, Accounts] to reflect the change in the licence's status to Ceased.



3. FACILITY LOCATION

The proposed facility is located in a remote area at a greenfield site on Meenaboll Hill which is part of the Glendowan Mountains, approximately 17 km southeast of Letterkenny, County Donegal.





3. FACILITY HISTORY

The proposed facility is located at Meenaboll Landfill Site, Meenaboll Hill which forms part of the Glendowan Mountains, a remote area approximately 17 km southeast of Letterkenny. The predominant natural surrounding of the site is conifer plantation. The site is underlain by metamorphic rocks. Within 2-3 km of the facility lie five residential properties. The area comprises 14.5 hectares where the landfill covers 4.5 hectares.

4. CONDITION OF SITE

Known contamination:

No known contamination to Groundwater or Soil

Remediation:

None required.

Other Environmental Liabilities:

No other environmental liabilities.

5. AGENCY'S ASSESSMENT

A site visit or exit audit was not carried out at this site as the licensable activity never commenced. The site was never developed to carry out the activity. Waste Licence W0215-01 ceased to have effect 3 years from the date of issue of the licence, i.e. on 12/07/2009.
