Dear Mr Walsh,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Forge Hill, Ballycurreen, Cork. I am directed to advise you of a failure to comply with Article 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

A site notice inspection was completed on the 4<sup>th</sup> August 2016 and it was found that site notices were not visible at the locations indicated on Drawing Number 4348-WL05 at that time.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations, to erect or fix a notice at the locations indicated on Drawing Number 4348-WL05 for a period of two months.

The Agency further requires you to submit a copy of the site notices erected/fixed and date stamped photos of the site notice at the locations indicated on Drawing Number 4348-WL05.



Grid. 5668E, 5688N). The MRF will process a maximum quantity of 82,000 tonnes per annum of mixed dry recyclable materials collected from households and commercial premises. Processing will comprise segregation, sorting and baling using modern sophisticated plant and machinery with all wastes handled indoors.

The following activities, as described in the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Act will be carried out at the site under the conditions of the Waste Licence:

Fourth Schedule (Waste Recovery Operations):
