<p>The Agency granted a revised Industrial Emissions licence subject to conditions, on 08/09/2016 to Nurendale, Reg. No. W0140-04, for Class 11.4(b): recovery, or a mix of recovery and disposal, of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes and Class 11.1: the recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, located at Rathdrinagh, Beauparc, Navan, County Meath.</p>
