Notification under Section 42(1E)(a) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 42(1E)(a) of the above referenced Acts, you are being notified that an application for a waste licence, to which Section 42 (1B)(b)(i) of the above Acts applies, was received by the Agency on 04/10/2016. The details of the application are set out below:

3. Provide any observations your authority has in relation to the licence application.

Please note that a response to this notice is required even if you have no observations to make.

Where it is intended to submit additional documentation with your observations, it would be much appreciated if you could include an electronic copy of all documents in pdf format on a CD ROM in order to facilitate the publishing of your observations and attachments to the Agency's website.

Please note that all further information received on this licence application will be made available on the Agency's website.
