No. P0986-01, for Class 11.4:</p> <p>(b) Recovery, or a mix of recovery and disposal, of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day involving one or more of the following activities, (other than activities to which the Urban Waste Water Treatment Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 254 of 2001) apply):</p> <p>(i) biological treatment.</p> <p>(c) Notwithstanding clause (b), when the only waste treatment activity carried out is anaerobic digestion, the capacity threshold for that activity shall be 100 tonnes per day</p> <p>located at Barryshall, Timoleague, Bandon, County Cork.</p>
