The EPA has recently issued a licence for the installation Timoleague Agri Gen Limited at Barryshall, Timoleague, Bandon, County Cork. The EPA is writing to inform you that it is the responsibility of Timoleague Agri Gen Limited, as the licensee, under Condition 11 of the licence, to ensure that notifications, records and reports are submitted to the EPA in accordance with the requirements of the licence.

The EPA enforces all licences through an online web based system and has largely removed the need for paper based communication. Therefore, in order to facilitate the prompt and efficient enforcement of your licence you are now required to register on the EDEN Portal at <https://edenireland.ie> through which enforcement of the licence and communication with the EPA will largely be based. The primary, secondary and tertiary contacts will be the persons notified of any correspondence/notifications from the EPA.

The management and communication of any incidents to the EPA shall be in accordance with the EPA's Guidance;


These guidance notes contain information on the contents and structure of an AER/PRTR. Licensees should have regard to this Guidance Note when fulfilling the reporting requirements of their license.
