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Dear Ms. Flanagan,

The Agency, in accordance with Regulation 33(1)(c) of the Wastewater Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 as amended, proposes to amend the licences granted to Irish Water, as referenced in Appendix 1 attached. Appendix 1 also details the particular amendment(s) being proposed for each licence or revised licence.

These amendments are arising from changes to legislation, the occurance of clerical errors and to provide further legal clarity to conditions attached to waste water discharge licences.

The Agency is minded to insert the conditions detailed in Appendix 2, in order to bring the licence into line with the Agency's current *modus operandi* for waste water discharge authorisations.

Article 33(2) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 as amended allows for the Agency to consult with licensees before amending a licence or revised licence.

Please find attached, in Appendix 1 & 2 of this letter, details of the proposed changes to be included in this technical amendment.

Please note that where there is an existing request for a wastewater discharge licence to be technically amended before the Agency, these proposed changes and the changes requested by the licensee will be assessed and addressed, where possible, as one single technical amendment.

- 4.1.1 The licensee shall undertake a risk based assessment of the discharge(s) in order to identify the relevant priority substances for monitoring. This assessment shall be undertaken in accordance with "Guidance on the Screening for Priority Substances for Waste Water Discharge Licences" issued by the Agency. Monitoring for the identified priority substances shall be carried out at least annually.
- 4.1.2 The licensee shall take such measures as are necessary to reduce or eliminate priority substances in the discharge(s). Implementation of the measures identified shall be reported on in the Programme of Improvements (required under Condition 5.1).
