**RE: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations**

Dear Mr. Milton,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Pretty Bush Waste Soils Recovery Facility, Kilquade, Townland of Priestsnewtown (& Knockroe), Kilcoole, Co. Wicklow. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Articles 7(1) and (2) of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

A site notice inspection was completed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2016 and it was found that site notices were not fixed appropriately at that time, as shown on enclosed photos.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations, to erect or fix a notice at the locations indicated on Drawing Number LW15-247-01-0100-105 for a period of two months.


The Agency further requires you to submit a copy of the site notices erected/fixed and date stamped photos of the site notice at the locations indicated on Drawing Number LW15-247-01-0100-105.

The evidence requested should be submitted within three weeks of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all drawings/maps should not exceed A3 in size.
