You will be required to give notice in an approved newspaper and erect a site notice under Article 35 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 to 2011, if the further information received is considered to contain significant additional data. Please do not publish a notice in an approved newspaper unless requested to do so by the Planning Authority. In such circumstances the four-week period for determining the application will run from the date that the notice is submitted to the Planning Authority.
