I refer to the above licence which was granted 6th February 2014. The main licensed activity is anaerobic digestion and this has not yet compended. The site has been unused since the Compost Centre ceased operation.

The likelihood is that the anaerobic digestion activity will commence in early to mid 2018. Waterford City & County Council would like to extend the commencement date of this activity to suit this programme for the following reasons:

- Redevelopment of the site had been held up due to legal issues. These have now been addressed and the Council formally approved the Section 183 motion on January 12th 2017. This allows a lease to be signed with FLI International Ltd who will now redevelop the Facility.
- There is a month Construction project during which the plant will be commissioned.
