RE:	Request for the Transfer of Licence , Reg No W0131-02, from Midland Waste Disposal Company Limited to Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited, CRO No 224173

Background

Licence Reg No W0131-02 was granted to Midland Waste Disposal Company Limited on the 03/02/2006. The licence was amended on 14 January 2013 and 29 June 2016. An Industrial Emissions Amendment issued in December 2015. A Transfer Application was received in June 2010 from Midland Waste Disposal Company Limited and Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited. The transfer of licence will allow Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited to operate the installation, currently operating at Clonmagaddan, Proudstown, Navan, Meath, under Licence Reg No W0131-02.

AES Navan are engaged with the collection and processing of non-hazardous household & commercial waste.

The Agency is informed that Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited is a limited company incorporated under the laws of Ireland and registered in the Companies Registration Office (Registered Number 224173).

Assessment

The application was assessed under Section 94 of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended. It is deemed to comply with the requirements of the above, as follows:

Requirements of Section 94(2) and 94(3)

- The application complies with Subsection (2) having been jointly made by the current licensee and the proposed transferee.
- The application was made in the form prescribed by the Agency.
- The application was accompanied by the appropriate fee.

Such information as may be required by Section 94(3)

- All costs associated with environmental liabilities i.e., closure plan/CRAMP and ELRA for the installation have been fully detailed by the licensee and have been approved by the Office of Environmental Enforcement (OEE).
- The transferee or any relevant person has not had an application for a licence refused.

Requirements of Section 94(5)

- Information in relation to the status of the proposed transferee as a 'Fit and Proper Person' has been provided and, based on a review of the information; the proposed transferee has no relevant convictions and has sufficient technical experience and support.
 - In relation to Financial Provision, OEE have confirmed that an on-demand performance bond has been agreed and is in place for Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited.
- The Senior Inspector (ELP) has reviewed the transfer application and considers, on the basis of the information provided in the application, that the proposed transferee can be deemed a Fit & Proper Person for the purpose of this transfer.

Requirements of Section 94(6)


The proposed transferee has stated in writing that they accept all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of a licence, that may arise.

OEE confirmed on 1 September 2016 that no outstanding legal issues required to be resolved.

Finance Unit confirmed on 1 September 2016 that no outstanding fees were due from the licensee.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the transfer of Industrial Emissions licence Reg. No. W0131-02 from Midland Waste Disposal Company Limited to Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited, CRO No 224173, is approved under Section 94 of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended.
