Re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Sheils,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at N&C Enterprises Limited, The Pit, Kilmeage, Naas, Co. Kildare. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

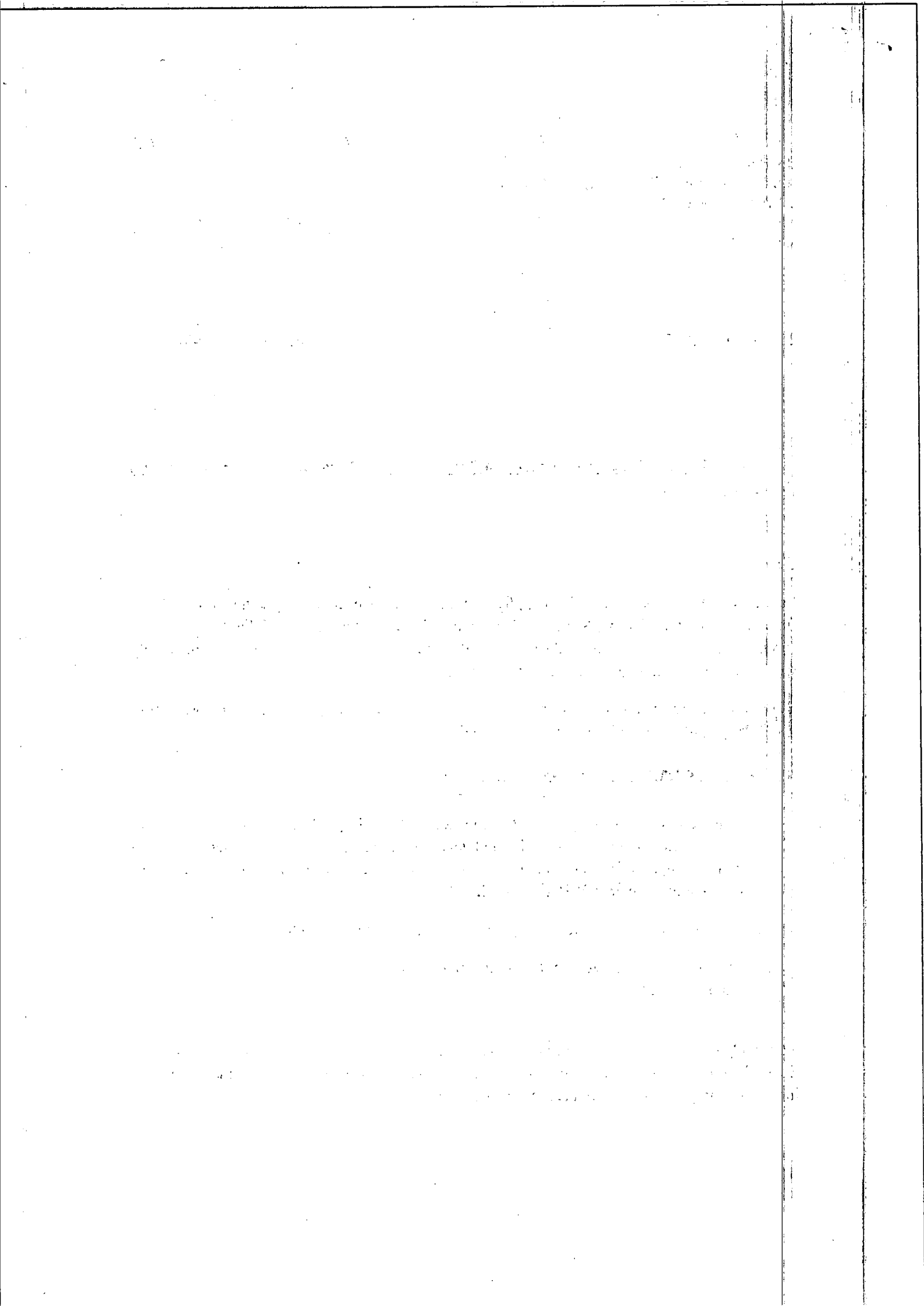
You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. In the context of waste previously deposited at the facility, please identify to the extent possible the sources of the elevated levels of ammonia, boron, chloride, electrical conductivity, potassium, sodium, sulphate, nitrate and faecal and total coliforms as detected in December 2015 and March 2016.
2. Submit a copy of a Waste Facility Permit reference number 126/2003.
3. Submit a copy of all Annual Environmental Reports associated with the above Waste Facility Permit.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (Application Form and EIS) which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.





In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within three weeks of the date of this notice. In addition submit two (2) copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
