

## **Attachment D2.3 Waste Acceptance Procedures**

All waste loads arriving at the site must pass over the weighbridge, where the following information is recorded:

- Description of the waste including waste types and relevant European Waste Catalogue (EWC) codes;
- The origin of the waste, including all customer details;
- Haulier Details;
- Vehicle Registration;
- The weight of the waste load.

Upon leaving the weighbridge, all waste delivery vehicles are directed to the appropriate off-loading points, where the materials are inspected to ensure they are suitable for processing. Any loads considered to be suspect are removed to a dedicated Quarantine Area for further inspection. If the inspection identifies that the materials do not meet the relevant acceptance criteria, the staff arrange for the load to be returned to the producer.

### Proposed Ash Waste Acceptance

The ash will be delivered in purpose built fully enclosed trailers that are weighed in at the weighbridge. It will be off-loaded inside the Materials Recovery building where it will be stored pending processing. The metals will be consigned to metal recovery facilities and the remaining ash will be sent to non-hazardous landfills for recovery/disposal.
