Note: The quantities of the different categories may vary subject to market conditions, but the overall limit of 250,000 tonnes will not be exceeded.

As part of the integration of the PANDA and Greenstar businesses, it is proposed to relocate the loose SRF storage to other licensed installations in Dublin, but to continue to accept food waste and residual MSW for bulking and transfer. The volume of ash generated at DWEL will be in the region of 130,000 tonnes annually. The food waste and residual MSW will be in the region of 14,000 tonnes/year.

The LoW codes for the wastes that may be accepted at the site are shown in Table D.2 (i). Rows have been completed for the waste types that will exceed >5% of the annual waste intake. The remaining wastes have been aggregated according to a waste category and individual LoW codes have been included.
