Re: Drehid Waste Management Facility (W0201-03) – Technical Amendment Request

Dear Mr. Clinton,

In light of the Agency's publication of *its Guidance Note on Daily and Intermediate Cover at Landfills*, we request a Technical Amendment of Schedule A of the existing licence as follows: Replace the existing Schedule A.2 and Table A.2.1 with the Schedule A.2 and Table A.2.1 set out below.

SCHEDULE A: Limitations

A.2 Waste Acceptance

Table A.2.1 Waste Categories and Quantities

Waste type (Note 1)	Maximum waste acceptance (Note 2)
Non-hazardous municipal, commercial and industrial wastes	<u>Landfill</u> 360,000 tonnes per annum until 31/12/2017 120,000 tonnes per annum from 1/1/2018 <u>Composting unit</u> 25,000 tonnes per annum <u>Landfill Engineering</u> No limit where fit for purpose and in accordance with Agency guidance
Inert waste	No limit where used in landfill engineering
TOTAL	385,000 tonnes per annum until 31/12/2017 145,000 tonnes per annum from 1/1/2018

Note 1: Any proposal to accept other compatible waste streams must be agreed in advance by the Agency and the total amount of waste must be within that specified.

Note 2: The individual limitation on waste processes may be varied with the agreement of the Agency subject to the overall total limit staying the same.
