

Attachment D.2 Waste Types & Quantities

The maximum annual tonnage of wastes that can be accepted are listed in Table D 2.1.

Table D 2.1 Total Waste Inputs

Biodegradable waste for composting	20,000

Note: The quantities of the different categories may vary subject to market conditions, but the overall limit of 250,000 tonnes will not be exceeded.

As part of the integration of the PANDA and Greenstar businesses, it is proposed to relocate to the SRF manufacturing and C&D processing lines to other licensed installations in Dublin, but to continue to accept skip waste and dry recyclables from the local area. The changes will reduce the incoming waste by almost 90 % of the amount accepted in 2016. The volume of ash generated at DWEL will be in the region of 130,000 tonnes annually. The skip waste and dry recyclables will be in the region of 14,000 tonnes/year.

The LoW codes for the wastes that may be accepted at the site are shown in Table D.2 (i). Rows have been completed for the waste types that will exceed >5% of the annual waste intake. The remaining wastes have been aggregated according to a waste category and individual LoW codes have been included.
