<b>RE:</b>	Request for the Transfer of Licence, Reg No W0129-02, from Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited to Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership, CRO No 590962.

## Background

Licence Reg No W0129-02 was granted to Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited on the 21/05/2008. A Transfer Application was received on 23/06/2017 from Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited and Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership. According to the applicants the basis for the transfer application is the Sale of facility to Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership. The transfer of licence will allow Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership to operate the installation, currently operating at Hollywood Great, Nags Head, The Naul, Dublin, under Licence Reg No W0129-02.

The Agency is informed that Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership is a limited liability company incorporated under the laws of Ireland and registered in the Companies Registration Office (Registered Number 590962).

Integrated Materials Solutions is a new business established in 2016. The primary business activity relates to the management of Construction and Demolition and Commercial and Industrial waste types. Subject to EPA approval the business will acquire the Hollywood landfill and will operate it in accordance with the Planning and Waste Licence conditions.

Intergrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership does not have any subsidiaries involved in the facility and does not have any prior operational presence in the state.

## Assessment

The application was assessed under Section 47 of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended. It is deemed to comply with the requirements of the above, as follows:

### Requirements of 47(2) and 47(3)

- The application complies with Subsection (2) having been jointly made by the current licensee and the proposed transferee.
- The application was made in the form prescribed by the Agency.
- The application was accompanied by the appropriate fee, in accordance with Article 43 of the Waste (Licensing) Regulations, as amended.

### **Such information as may be required by Section 47(3)**

The Environmental Liabilities Risk Assessment (ELRA) and CRAMP for the facility have been approved by the Office of Environmental Enforcement (OEE).

- The transferee or any relevant person has not had an application for a licence refused.

### **Requirements of Section 47(5)**

- Information in relation to the status of the proposed transferee as a 'Fit and Proper Person' has been provided and, based on a review of the information; the proposed transferee has no relevant convictions and has sufficient technical experience and support.

Financial Provision has been approved by OEE and is in place with all relevant documents executed with the OEE Director on 22 June 2017 in relation to the proposed transferee.

The Senior Inspector (ELP) has reviewed the transfer application and considers, on the basis of the information provided in the application, that the proposed transferee can be deemed a Fit & Proper Person for the purpose of this transfer.

### **Requirements of Section 47(6)**

- The proposed transferee has stated in writing that they accept all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of a licence, that may arise.

OEE confirmed on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2017 that no outstanding legal issues required to be resolved.

Finance Unit confirmed on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2017 that no outstanding fees were due from the licensee.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the transfer Waste licence Reg. No. W0129-02 from Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited to Integrated Materials Solutions Limited Partnership, CRO No 590962, is approved under Section 47 of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.
