APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A LICENCE

Rilta Environmental Ltd, Block 402, Grants Drive, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, County Dublin, is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a review of Industrial Emissions Licence (W0185-01) for its existing Hazardous Waste Transfer Station at Site No. 14-A1, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, County Dublin. It is proposed to accept, package and temporarily store pending export 30,000 tonnes /year of hazardous air pollution control residue. There will be no change to the total quantity of waste accepted annually.

The class and nature of the industrial emissions directive activity in accordance with the First Schedule to the Act of 1992, as amended are:

- 11.1 The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required;
- 11.2.(b) Disposal or recovery of hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 tonnes per day involving the following activities:
- (b) physio-chemical treatment
- (c) blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the other activities listed in paragraph 11.2 or 11.3
- (d) repackaging prior to submission to any of the activities listed in paragraph 11.2 or 11.3
- (f) recycling or reclamation of inorganic materials other than metals or metal compounds
- 11.4.(a) Disposal of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 50 tonnes per day involving one or more of the following activities:
- (ii) physio-chemical treatment
- 11.6 Temporary storage of hazardous waste, (other than waste referred to in paragraph 11.5) pending any of the activities referred to in paragraph 11.2, 11.3, 11.5 or 11.7 with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where the waste is generated

A copy of the application for the review of the licence may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the head-quarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the licence.
