Dear Mr O'Brien,

I refer to your application for a licence review, which was received on 13 April 2017.

I am to advise that clarification is provided on the requirements of Questions 1-3 of the Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) issued on 19 October 2017. Please have regard to the clarification below in considering your response. On receipt of the information required the Agency may complete a comprehensive assessment of the application review:

- Submit a coded summary table of lands that slurry will be exported to. The table should include a farm number/code, county, area of land available for spreading (in acres/hectares) and the import capacity in m<sup>3</sup>. The total import capacity available should also be provided. Confirm or otherwise that there is sufficient spread-lands available for the quantity of slurry generated per annum by the activity, please include the quantity of organic fertiliser that is produced at the installation/proposed installation.
- The AA screening (SCAIL) conducted by the Agency was based on the information contained within the licence application. In terms of air emissions from the installation, limited information was received on model input parameters such as type of ventilation at the installation, number of fans, fan diameter and flow-rates m<sup>3</sup>/s. Where this information can be obtained and provided, the Agency will examine the data and re-run the SCAIL model <http://www.scail.ceh.ac.uk/>. The outcome of this re-run will allow the Agency to review the level of Appropriate Assessment required.

In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

On consideration of the need for an extension of time for the applicant to provide a full response to the matters above, the Agency is requesting the submission of the response by the **19<sup>th</sup> January 2018**.

In the circumstances you should make arrangements to have the required information (1 signed original, 1 hardcopy and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should be directed to Ms Elizabeth Leacy, Administration Officer, Environmental Licensing Programme, Office of Environmental Sustainability.
