## <u>APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A LICENCE</u>

## **SITE NOTICE**

Miltown Composting Systems Ltd., Miltownmore, Fethard, Co. Tipperary is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for an Industrial Emissions Licence to replace its existing Waste Licence W0270-01 for its composting facility at Miltownmore, Fethard, Co. Tipperary (ITM coordinates - 615687E, 633475N). It is intended to increase the daily organic waste throughput at the facility to 160 tonnes per day to a maximum of 50,000 tonnes per annum. It is also intended that the licence application will include for the use of an existing Integrated Constructed Wetland (ICW) system for accepting surface water runoff from facility roofs and non-process yard surfaces.

The Class and nature of the industrial emissions directive activity in accordance with the First Schedule to the EPA Act of 1992, as amended, is:

11.4 (b) Recovery, or a mix of recovery and disposal, of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day involving one or more of the following activities, (other than activities to which the Urban Waste Water Treatment Regulations 2001(S.I. No. 254 of 2001) apply:

- (i) biological treatment
- (ii) pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration

An Environmental Impact Statement and any further information relating to the effects on the environment of the emissions from the activity which may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application will be available on the Agency's website or at the headquarters of the Agency. A copy of the Environmental Impact Statement has also been submitted to Tipperary County Council Planning Department. A copy of the Industrial Emissions Licence application may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application of the licence.
