Dear Mr Fay B.Agr.Sc.

I refer to your application for a licence.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, that the following information is required in support of the application under Regulation 9 of the Regulations:

1. In relation to the storm water collection system, provide the following [Regulation 9(2)(g)]:
 - (a) Clarify the number and location of surface water discharge points at the installation, (including the 6 digit grid reference in each case) and provide an updated labelled map of these discharge points using SW nomenclature (e.g. SW1). Include any proposed additional surface water discharge points(s) and associated monitoring locations;
 - (b) Identify any appropriate mitigation measures (such as silt traps/swales) which are / shall be installed prior to the surface water discharge points.
 - (c) Clarify how wash water is prevented from discharging through the surface water discharge points.

2. Confirm if a back-up generator is on site and provide details of the type and quantity of fuel used for the back-up generator, and the capacity and type of the fuel storage facilities on site [Regulation 9(2)(f)].
3. In relation to the water supply for the installation you are requested to provide the following [Regulation 9(2)(f)]:
 - (a) Confirm if a private well is used as a water supply for the site, and if applicable provide a labelled drawing and a 6 digit grid reference identifying the location of the ground water well.
 - (b) Confirm if there are any other sources of water used for the activity. If applicable provide the name of any Group Water Scheme which provides water for the installation.
 - (c) Where available, furnish the results of any analysis that has been carried out on any water from well(s) within the installation boundary.
4. With regards to washwater / soiled water produced by the activity, please provide the following [Regulation 9(2)(g)]:
 - (a) Confirm the volumes of washwater (in m³) generated by the current and proposed activity per annum.
 - (b) Confirm the total storage capacity for washwater/soiled water available for the current and proposed activity. Confirm whether 26 weeks storage capacity is available on-site. If the storage capacity is supplemented by off-site storage please identify the type and location of the off-site storage.
5. Provide details of the estimated quantities of the following to be used per annum for both the existing and proposed activity [Regulation 9(2)(f)]:
 - (a) Electricity;
 - (b) Fuel,
 - (c) Feed,
 - (d) Water.
6. With regards to poultry litter/manure (organic fertiliser) produced by the activity, please provide the following [Regulation 9(2)(g)]:
 - (a) A copy of the Record 3 form (as required under article 23 of the European Union (Good Agricultural Practice for Protection of waters) Regulations 2014) for 2017.
7. A screening for Appropriate Assessment has not been provided in your application. You are required to carry out an appropriate Assessment Screening as part of your reply to this notice.

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In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within **2 weeks** of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make arrangements to have the required documents (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency. Your response to this request should be directed to Elizabeth Leacy, Administration Officer, Office Environmental Sustainability.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact Ms Eimer Godsil at the number above.
