**RE: Section 14 Direction in relation to illegal deposition of waste material at Kilsaran,  
Tullykane, Dunsany, Co Meath**

Dear Mr. Gallagher,

Meath County Council is the competent Authority with regard to the regulation and enforcement of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended. Under Section 39 of this Act, you are required to hold a Waste Facility Permit to import, recover or dispose of waste on your lands, in this case at Kilsaran, Tullykane, Dunsany, Co Meath. As per Section 39 of the WMA 1996 as amended, subject to subsections (4) and (7), *a person shall not dispose of or undertake the recovery of waste (including the treatment of waste) at a facility, on or after such date as may be prescribed, save under and in accordance with a licence under this Part (in this Act referred to as a "waste licence") that is in force in relation to the carrying on of the activity concerned at that facility.*

The lands in question at Kilsaran, Tullykane, Dunsany, Co Meath are not authorised to accept any type of waste and do not hold a waste licence/waste facility permit or certificate of registration. You have contravened section 39 of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.

On 16/12/2016, Meath County Council received a complaint from a member of the public alleging that Kilsaran were storing waste without the appropriate waste authorization. Ciara Coughlan (authorised waste enforcement officer with Meath County Council), investigated the complaint on 12/01/2017, 17/01/2017 (with Fergus Gallagher) and again on 07/02/2017. Ciara Coughlan observed an amount of concrete and bituminous waste mixed with clay at a location within the Kilsaran site, as per maps emailed to you on 13/02/2017.

With regard to the Kilsaran, Tullykane, Dunsany site, you are required to carry out measures as per section 14 of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended and recommended by Ciara Coughlan, authorised waste enforcement officer with Meath County Council.


Meath County Council hereby instructs you to carry out the following measures listed 1 – 3 as below;

1. Immediately cease the practice of importing and storing waste on lands at Kilsaran, Tullykane, Dunsany, Co Meath.
2. **All of the waste** which is on the lands at Kilsaran, Tullykane, Dunsany, Co Meath shall be removed by an **authorised waste collector** and transported to an appropriately **licensed / permitted facility**, which is licensed to receive such waste. This measure must be complied with by **end April 2017**, unless otherwise agreed with Ciara Coughlan.
3. All disposal / recovery **receipts/dockets (wcp haulier and landfill)** are to be submitted to Meath County Council, once all the waste material has been removed off site and within 3 calendar months of the date of this direction letter.

Please take note that this *Section 14 Direction* is without prejudice to any legal proceedings, Meath County Council may take against you in respect of any contravention of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended and the Regulations made there under.


Dear Ms. Tuomey,

I refer to the Section 14 Direction issued by your office to Kilsaran dated 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017.

In compliance with the measures instructed, all waste was removed from the lands at Tullykane by the end of April 2017. This waste was removed to an approved recovery facility owned and operated by Kilsaran Concrete at Gallstown, Grangebellew, County Louth – Certificate of Registration Number COR-LH-13-0004-01 (copy enclosed). The waste was delivered using Kilsaran trucks authorised under Waste Collection Permit Number NWCPO-04-06153-02 (copy enclosed).



Otherwise an application for a review of this permit shall be made at least 60 working days prior to the expiry date of this permit to the National Waste Collection Permit Office, Offaly County Council, Áras an Chontae, Charleville Road, Tullamore, Co. Offaly. This permit may be revoked under Article 29 of the Waste Management (Collection Permit) Regulations, 2007 and the Waste Management (Collection Permit) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008.




**This measure was fully complied with as per inspection carried out on 03/05/2017 by Ciara Coughlan. Waste has been removed from the lands.**

I confirm that on foot of the Section 14 Direction issued by Meath County Council on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017 a total of 1,406.03 tonnes of waste concrete (17 01 01) and 27.80 tonnes of bituminous mixtures containing other than those mentioned in 17 03 01 (17 03 02) was removed from the Tullykane Site to a Kilsaran owned and operated waste recovery facility at Gallstown Quarry, Co. Louth (COR-LH-13-0004-01). [Kilsaran's](#) trucks issued with a valid Waste Collection Permit (NWCP0-04-06153-02) were used to transport this material to Gallstown.
