Dear Mr Naughton

I refer to your licence application in respect of Nurendale, Rathdrinagh, Beauparc, Navan, County Meath, Register No. W0140-05.

The EPA is currently processing a high number of applications for industrial emission licences. We are working to process all applications as quickly as possible with the current resources available. Applications are being processed on a priority basis. Our decisions are made subject to completing all the required environmental assessments and the development of appropriate measures to ensure that licence conditions prevent pollution and ensure that best available techniques are applied.

The timeline to complete an application assessment depends on resources; our technical assessment; such further information as may be required being provided; public submissions and objections. I can advise that your application is under assessment and it is planned to issue a decision by 2 July 2018.

I am therefore to request your consent, in accordance with Regulation 14(2) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, to extend the appropriate period by which the Agency must issue a proposed determination to **2 July 2018**.
