Dear Mr Hussy

I refer to your application for an Industrial Emission licence review, which was received by the Agency on 31/07/2017.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, that the following information is required in support of the application under Regulation 9 of the Regulations:

1. Update the Environmental Impact Statement to meet the requirements of an Environmental Impact Assessment Report in accordance with the 2014 EIA Directive.
2. Provide a description of the current and proposed waste activities by completing the following table (the first row is completed as an example and should be deleted to make way for real information):

3. Clarify, based on the information provided in point 2 above, if there will be a discharge of trade effluent to foul sewer from the installation.
4. Provide details of the sewer network and associated wastewater treatment plant to which the storm water and trade effluent (if yes in point 3 above) discharges.
5. It is noted that the current licence (W0185-01) sets emission limits values and monitoring requirements on an air emission point reference Tf A1. Confirm if this emission point is still in place and is required in the future?

6. Confirm the location of the installation providing the national grid reference coordinates (12 digit 6E, 6N).


In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *eight weeks* of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make arrangements to have the required documents (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency. Your response to this request should be directed to Fiona Berry, Administration Officer, Office Environmental Sustainability.
