Dear Mr. Brady,

I refer to your application for a licence for Doon Farm Enterprises Limited, application reference P1024-02.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, that the following information is required in support of the application under Regulation 9 of the Regulations:

- 1. In your response dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018 to the Agency's correspondence dated 29 May 2017, the following information requested in a. and b. below was not included. The information outstanding is as follows:
  - (a) In the context of the publication of the BAT Conclusions for the intensive rearing of poultry or pigs in the Official Journal of the European Union as Commission Implementing Decision (EU 2017/302), you are required to review the installation activities against the relevant BAT Conclusion requirements as set out in the document referenced above and demonstrate whether your installation meets BAT requirements and <a href="https://example.com/how-these-requirements">how these requirements are satisfied.</a>
  - (b) Tabulate <u>all</u> of the BAT conclusions from the CID document for the Intensive Rearing of Poultry or pigs (Feb 2017). For each BAT conclusion, indicate whether it is applicable to your installation. The following details should also be included in your table.

For <u>all applicable</u> BAT conclusions, state if it is proposed to be put in place and the timeline for implementation. Details of any proposals must be provided. Where you do not propose to meet the requirements of a particular BAT conclusion, provide reasons and a justification [Regulation 9(2)(h)].

2. The application specifies that the farm will operate as a 500 sow integrated pig farm. It is noted that your response dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018 stated that the site will have accommodation for 3,500 production pigs. Please clarify the following (in accordance with Regulation 9(2)(c)):

- (a) Confirm the number of farrowing and dry sow places. It should be noted that the number of places for sows should include served gilts as per Danish ECJ judgement case C-585/10.
- (b) Confirm the number of places for maiden gilts that will be housed on site.
- (c) Confirm the number of places for weaners that will be housed on site.
- 3. In the coded summary table of lands that slurry will be exported to, provided in Appendix No.5 of your response dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018, the table provided did not include the county or counties where land is available for spreading. Provide an updated table to include the county or counties. (Regulation 9(2)(g)).
- 4. Clarify the approximate quantity of diesel stored in the backup generator fuel storage tank [Regulation 9(2)(f)].
- 5. The grid reference provided for the storm water discharge point marked SW-1 of E588849 N521133 in your response dated 3rd April 2018 is incorrect. In accordance with Regulation 9(2)(j) provide the following:
  - (a) Clarify the location of surface water discharge point at the installation, (including the 6 digit grid reference) and provide an updated map of the discharge point where necessary.
  - (b) Clarify all surface water pathways between any storm water discharge point and the local watercourse.

In addition to the above, please provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within 4 months of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make arrangements to have the required documents (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM or equivalent) submitted to the Agency. Your response to this request should be directed to Noeleen Keavey, Administration Officer, Office of Environmental Sustainability.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact Mary Sheehan at the number above.
