**NOTIFICATION OF WASTE LICENCE APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY BY GCHL LTD FOR THE OPERATION OF A WASTE RECOVERY FACILITY ON LANDS AT BALLINDERRY PIT, CARBURY, NAAS, CO. KILDARE (NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE E: 269326, N: 239184).**

In accordance with Article 9 (1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended, GCHL Ltd, Naas Industrial Estate, Naas, Co. Kildare hereby give written notice of the following application for a Waste License Application to the Environmental Protection Agency.

**APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE**

GCHL Ltd., Naas Industrial Estate, Naas, Co. Kildare give notice that a waste licence is being sought for the operation of an inert waste recovery facility on lands at Ballinderry Pit, Carbury, Naas, Co. Kildare (National Grid Reference E: 269326, N 239184).

The proposed development is the importation and recovery of inert soils and stone for the phased restoration of a sand and gravel pit to a contoured landform that will be in keeping with the surrounding landscape. It is proposed that up to circa 400,000 tonnes per annum of inert materials, subject to market demand, will be accepted to site.

The principal activity is Class R 5 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended (recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials). Other activities include Class R 13 of the Fourth Schedule (Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)).

A copy of the application for a Waste Licence, the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection on the Agency's website or inspected at, or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency.
