Nurendale, Rathdrinagh, Beauparc, Navan, County Meath is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a review of Industrial Emissions Licence (W0140-04) for its existing Materials Recovery Facility at Rathdrinagh, Beauparc, Navan, County Meath. It is proposed to accept and process non-hazardous incinerator bottom ash from the Dublin Waste to Energy Ltd plant at Poolbeg, Dublin. The processing will involve the removal of the ferrous and non-ferrous metals so as to facilitate the further treatment of the bottom ash. The anaerobic digestion plant permitted under the current licence will not be installed. There will be no change to the total quantity of waste accepted annually.

The class and nature of the industrial emissions directive activity in accordance with the First Schedule to the Act of 1992, as amended are:

11.1 The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required;

11.4.(b) Recovery, or a mix of recovery and disposal, of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day involving one or more of the following activities, (other than activities to which the Urban Waste Water Treatment Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 254 of 2001) apply):

- (i) biological treatment;
- (ii) pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration;
- (iii) treatment of slags and ashes;
- (iv) treatment in shredders of metal waste, including waste electrical and electronic equipment and end-of-life vehicles and their components.

A copy of the application for the licence may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the licence.
